Thumb Brewery Pilsner - \$1.75 / \$5.00 / \$18.00

This beer is the classic summertime drink. Easy, light, refreshing, and true to style. Ahhhh summertime...Pilsner / Caseville, MI / 5.2 ABV / 29 IBU

Thumb Brewery Hefeweizen - \$2.00 / \$5.50 / \$20.00

Traditional German ingredients create a sweet, light bodied session beer. Banana and clove carry into the beer itself. Hefeweizen / Caseville, MI / 5.1 ABV / 12.2 IBU

Thumb Brewery Gose - \$2.00 / \$5.50 / \$20.00

Highly-carbonated, tart and fruity wheat ale with a restrained coriander and salt character. Gose wheat ale / Caseville, MI / 4.3 ABV / 10 IBU

Thumb Brewery Kona Coffee Stout - \$2.50 / \$6.75 / \$25.00

Brewed with Hawaiian Kona Coffee, this brew has a slight fruity aroma and taste. Kona Coffee Stout / Caseville, MI / 6.0 ABV / 35 IBU

Thumb Brewery Amber Lager - \$2.25 / \$6.00 / \$22.00

Rich and malty with the proper amount of caramel and hop. Woody and nutty provide a rustic aroma / Caseville, MI / 5.0 ABV / 25 IBU

Thumb Brewery West Coast Style IPA - \$2.25 / \$6.00 / \$22.00

This hopped-up IPA is piney with notes of tropical fruit; dry with high bitterness. IPA lovers, judge this one...IPA / Caseville, MI / 7.6 ABV / 85 IBU

Thumb Brewery Oatmeal Stout - \$2.00 / \$5.50 / \$20.00

This is what you've been searching for! A medium-bodied stout with hints of chocolate and coffee. / Caseville, MI / 5.2 ABV / 50 IBU

Dark and Malty:

Midland Brewing Copper Harbor Amber - \$6.00 / \$22.00

Perfectly balanced brew with a sweet, toasty malt character and rich copper color. This beer is supremely smooth. Midland MI / ABV 5.3% / 14 IBU

Big Lake Michigan Amber - \$6.75 / \$25.00

This copper red ale is malt forward but well-balanced with floral and citrus hops. Amber Ale / Holland, MI / 5.7 ABV / 29 IBU

Pigeon Hill Salted Caramel Porter - Nitro - \$7.50 / \$29.00

A traditional porter takes on caramel and salt. The chocolate malt gives it flavors that reminds you of a piece of candy. / Muskegon, MI / 6.0 ABV / 20 IBU

Greenbush Distorter Porter - \$7.00 / \$26.00

Aroma of toasty malts, coconut. Flavor rich, roasty, not complex. Smooth mouth feel. / Sawyer, MI / 7.2 ABV / 50 IBU

Fruity and Crisp:

Petoskey Blueberry Crush - \$6.50 / \$24.00

This is a blueberry waffle cone ale with a very juicy blueberry taste combined with a strong blueberry aroma. Cream Ale Petoskey, MI / 7.0 ABV / 15 IBU

Shorts Soft Parade Shandy - \$6.00 / \$22.00

Soft Parade + homemade lemonade. Raspberry in color and smells like fresh berry lemonade. Finishes faintly with taste of fruit candy. Bellaire, MI / 4.2% ABV / 12 IBU

IPA's:

North Peak Diaboli IPA - \$6.50 / \$24.00

Hops from nose to tail. Unfiltered and dry-hopped with Michigan grown Chinook and Cascade hops. Smooth malt character and citrus pine aroma. Dexter MI / 6.66% / ABV 6.66 72 IBU

Bells Official - \$6.75 / \$25.00

This Hazy IPA is double dry-hopped resulting in complex peach and tropical notes with a dry finish and balanced bitterness. Hazy IPA / Kalamazoo, MI / 6.4 ABV / 55 IBU

Old Nation M43 - \$7.50 / \$29.00

A hazy New England IPA of tropical notes of pineapple, mango and grapefruit with a surprisingly delicate aroma. New England IPA / Williamston, MI / 6.8 ABV / 65 IBU

Pilsner, American Lager, Other:

Founders Oktoberfest Marzen - \$6.50 / \$24.00

Imported German malts and hops with a beautiful lager yeast for the finish. Pours a gorgeous copper hue with a rich, malty and slightly sweet backbone. Grand Rapids MI / 6.0 ABV / 20 IBU

Lake Brothers Lager - \$6.00 / \$23.00

Brewed with only four ingredients: hops, Midwestern malted barley, yeast and Great Lakes water. Amber in color, this beer pours brilliantly clear with a rich malt aroma and a pleasant finish. Detroit MI / 5.0 ABV / 24 IBU

Jolly Pumpkin - \$6.00 / \$23.00

Low-calorie, sour type white ale brewed in Belgium's bière blanche tradition. Spiced with orange peel and coriander, you'll find it refreshingly tart, with a wonderfully dry finish. Dexter, MI / 4.8% ABV / 15 IBU

Odd Side Beer Me - \$5.50 / \$20.00

This American lager is the perfect session beer. Clean, easy and drinkable / Grand Haven MI / 4.5% ABV / 25 IBU

New Holland Full Circle - \$6.00 / \$23.00

A kölsch-style beer, refreshing and balanced. The soft, well-rounded malt character, light hop profile with a crisp finish. Holland, MI / 4.9% ABV / n/a IBU

Budweiser or Bud Light - \$4.50

A mammothly produced pale-lager that is rather boring. Light is more boring than Bud but you can drink more. ABV unimportant / IBU - really not important
